Legal Practitioners Regulations

AMENDMENT OF LEGAL PRACTITIONERS REGULATIONS

1. Commencement

These Regulations come into operation on the commencement of section 32 of the Legal Practitioners Amendment Act 2000.

2. New regulation

The Legal Practitioners Regulations are amended by adding at the end the following:

"4. Notice by interstate legal practitioner of commencing to practise

"For the purposes of section 134J(1) of the Act, an interstate legal practitioner must lodge a written notice within 10 working days after commencing to practise in the Territory."
