AMENDMENT OF TENNANT CREEK (GARBAGE) BY-LAWS

OCCUPIER TO KEEP GARBAGE RECEPTACLE

By-law 4 of the Tennant Creek (Garbage) By-laws is amended -

- (a) by omitting clause (1)(a) and substituting the following:
"(a) keep on the premises one garbage receptacle of a type that the council has, subject to clause (3), approved by resolution;"
- (b) by omitting from clause (1)(b), (c), (d) and (e) "a garbage receptacle" (wherever occurring) and substituting "the garbage receptacle";
- (c) by omitting from clause (1)(f) "a receptacle" and substituting "the garbage receptacle";
- (d) by omitting from clause (1)(g) and (h) "a garbage receptacle" and substituting "the garbage receptacle"; and
- (e) by adding at the end the following:

"(3) The council must not approve a type of garbage receptacle for the purposes of clause (1)(a) unless the receptacle -

- (a) has a capacity of not more than 240 litres;

- (b) is impervious to moisture and vermin; and
 - (c) is fitted with wheels and handles."
