AMENDMENTS OF ADMINISTRATION AND PROBATE REGULATIONS

1. Commencement

These Regulations come into operation on the date on which section 3 of the *Statute Law Revision Act (No. 2) 1998* commences.

2. Principal Regulations

The Administration and Probate Regulations are in these Regulations referred to as the Principal Regulations.

*Notified in the *Northern Territory Government Gazette* on 1 April 1999.

Administration and Probate Regulations

3. Fees

Regulation 2 of the Principal Regulations is amended by omitting "the Schedule" and substituting "Schedule 1".

4. New regulation

The Administration and Probate Regulations are amended by inserting after regulation 2 the following:

"2AA. Relevant countries

"For the purposes of the definition of 'relevant country' in section 6 of the Act, the countries and parts of countries specified in Schedule 2 are prescribed."

5. Schedule

The Schedule to the Principal Regulations is amended by omitting "SCHEDULE" and substituting "SCHEDULE 1".

6. New schedule

The Principal Regulations are amended by inserting after the Schedule the following:
