Regulations under the Liquor Act

AMENDMENT OF LIQUOR REGULATIONS

Days and times at which liquor may be sold

Regulation 4 of the Liquor Regulations is amended -

- (a) by omitting from subregulation (1) "The times" and substituting "Subject to suregulation (1AA), the times";
- (b) by inserting after subregulation (1) the following:

"(1AA) The times and days that liquor may be sold for consumption away from the premises under a store licence are -

(a) Monday to Friday (inclusive) - between 10.00am and 10.00pm; and

(b) Saturday and public holidays - between 9.00am and 10.00pm,

or such shorter periods of time within the times specified in paragraphs (a) and (b), and on such days, as the Commission may determine in respect of a particular store licence or particular store licences.";

(c) by omitting from subregulation (1A) "subregulation (1)" and substituting "subregulation (1) or (1AA)"; and

(d) by omitting subregulation (2) and substituting the following:

"(2) In this regulation –

'public holidays' means public holidays observed in the Territory pursuant to sections 5 and 6 of the *Public Holidays Act*, but does not include Good Friday and Christmas Day;'

'store licence' means a licence that authorises the sale of liquor for removal and consumption away from the licensed premises and that is endorsed with the words '<u>AUTHORITY - STORE</u>'.".
