# AMENDMENT OF POLICE ADMINISTRATION (FEES) REGULATIONS

### 1. Commencement

These Regulations come into operation on the date fixed by the Minister by notice in the *Gazette*.

## Repeal and substitution

The Schedule to the Police Administration (Fees) Regulations is repealed and the following substituted:
