# AMENDMENTS OF MOTOR ACCIDENTS (COMPENSATION) APPEAL TRIBUNAL RULES

## 1. PRINCIPAL RULES

The Motor Accidents (Compensation) Appeal Tribunal Rules are in these Rules referred to as the Principal Rules.

## INTERPRETATION

Rule 3 of the Principal Rules is amended by omitting from the definition of "Master" in subrule (1) all the words after "Supreme Court Act".

## 3. PROCEDURAL

Rule 4 of the Principal Rules is amended by omitting from subrule (1) "The Master" and substituting "A Registrar or an acting Registrar of the Supreme Court appointed under the Supreme Court Act".

## 4. NEW RULE

The Principal Rules are amended by inserting after rule 4 the following:

## "4A. POWERS OF MASTER

"The Master may exercise all the powers of the Tribunal under these Rules other than the power to conduct the hearing of a reference.".

## 5. INSTITUTION OF REFERENCE TO TRIBUNAL

Rule 5 of the Principal Rules is amended by omitting from subrule (2) "5" and substituting "15".

## 6. ANSWER

Rule 6 of the Principal Rules is amended by omitting from subrule (2) "5" and substituting "15".

## 7. COSTS

Rule 11 of the Principal Rules is amended by omitting from subrule (5) "they were a judgment debt obtained in" and substituting "the order were a judgment for the payment of money given by".
