AMENDMENT OF LEGAL PRACTITIONERS RULES

ENTRY INTO ARTICLES OF CLERKSHIP

Rule 22 of the Legal Practitioners Rules is amended -

- (a) by omitting from subrule (1) (a) "on his or her own account or in partnership"; and
- (b) by omitting from subrule (3) paragraphs (b) and(c) and substituting the following:
- "(b) the applicant is of good fame and character;
- (c) the person with whom the applicant proposes to enter or has entered into articles of clerkship is a person referred to in subrule (1); and
- (d) the articles of clerkship that the applicant proposes to enter or has entered into will provide the applicant with satisfactory experience.".
