Regulations under the Public Health Act

AMENDMENTS OF PUBLIC HEALTH (BARBERS' SHOPS) REGULATIONS

1. PRINCIPAL REGULATIONS

The Public Health (Barber's Shops) Regulations are in these Regulations referred to as the Principal Regulations.

2. REGISTRATION OF BARBERS' SHOPS

Regulation 5 of the Principal Regulations is amended -

- (a) by omitting from subregulation (5) "is in force until 31 of December next following" and substituting "remains in force for twelve months from";
- (b) by omitting from subregulation (6) "\$25" and substituting "\$65"; and
- (c) by adding at the end the following:

"(8) The occupier of premises registered under this regulation shall, not later than 28 days before the registration expires, make application to renew the registration.".

## 3. FURTHER AMENDMENTS

The Principal Regulations are further amended as set out in the Schedule.

## TRANSITIONAL 4.

(1) Where, on the commencement of these Regulations, premises are registered as a barber's shop under the Principal Regulations and an application is made to renew the registration of the premises in accordance with regulation 5(8) of the Principal Regulations, as inserted by these Regulations, the Chief Medical Officer may, notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the Principal Regulations, register the premises as a barber's shop for such period as the Chief Medical Officer thinks fit and the fee in respect of such registration shall be pro-rata the fee specified in regulation 5(6) of the Principal Regulations having regard to the period of the registration.

(2) Subregulation (1) applies only in respect of the first application for the renewal of the registration of premises made under regulation 5(8) of the Principal Regulations after the commencement of these Regulations.
