Regulations 1995, No. 1*

By-laws under the *Local Government Act*

AMENDMENTS OF TENNANT CREEK (CONTROL OF DOGS) BY-LAWS

1. INTERPRETATION

By-law 3 of the Tennant Creek (Control of Dogs) By-laws is amended -

- (a) by omitting the definition of "attack" and substituting the following:

"'attack', in relation to the actions of a dog, means any action which causes injury or damage to any other animal or to any person or property, and includes any physical contact between the dog and another animal or a person or property whether or not any injury or damage results from the physical contact;"; and

- (b) by omitting the definition of "menace" and substituting the following:

"'menace', in relation to the actions of a dog, means an action that creates a reasonable apprehension in a person that the dog is likely to attack the person or another person or an animal owned or in the control of the person or other person, and includes a reasonable apprehension that the dog may escape, or be released from restraint, to attack a person or animal;".

Tennant Creek (Control of Dogs) By-laws

2. UNREGISTERED DOGS

By-law 21 of the Tennant Creek (Control of Dogs) By-laws is amended -

(a) by inserting after clause (1), the following:

"(1A) An offence under clause (1) is a regulatory offence."; and

(b) by inserting, after clause (3)(c), the following:

"(ca) a dog under the age of 3 months;".

3. DOGS ATTACKING OR MENACING PERSONS OR ANIMALS

By-law 29 of the Tennant Creek (Control of Dogs) By-laws is amended -

(a) by adding at the end of clause (1) the following:

"Penalty: \$500."; and

(b) by inserting, after clause (1), the following:

"(1A) An offence under clause (1) is a regulatory offence.".
