Regulations under the Gaming Control Act

AMENDMENT OF GAMING CONTROL (GAMING MACHINES) REGULATIONS

COMMENCEMENT

These Regulations shall come into operation on 1 January 1996.

GAMING MACHINE TURNOVER LEVY

Regulation 7 of the Gaming Control (Gaming Machines) Regulations is amended by omitting subregulation (1) and substituting the following:

- "(1) The holder of a permit in relation to a gaming machine for a purpose specified in section $49\,(1)\,(a)$ of the Act shall, where the gaming machine is on premises in respect of which a licence -
 - (a) referred to in section 35(1)(b) of the Liquor Act is in force, pay 6%; or
 - (b) referred to in section 35(1)(c) of the Liquor Act is in force, pay 3%,

of the total value of coins, tokens or credits used to play or operate the gaming machine as gaming machine turnover levy.".

Gaming Control (Gaming Machines) Regulations

3. TRANSITIONAL

- (1) In this regulation, "permit holder" means the holder of a permit in relation to a gaming machine for a purpose specified in section 49(1)(a) of the Act where the gaming machine is on premises in respect of which a licence under section 35(1)(c) of the *Liquor Act* is in force.
- (2) Where, before the commencement of these Regulations, a permit holder had applied for a gaming machine licence under the Gaming Machine Act and the application had not been granted or refused before that commencement, regulation 7 of the Gaming Control (Gaming Machines) Regulations, as amended by these Regulations, shall not apply, subject to subregulation (3), to or in relation to the permit holder.
- (3) Where an application referred to in subregulation (2) is refused, regulation 7 of the Gaming Control (Gaming Machines) Regulations, as amended by these Regulations, shall apply to and in relation to the permit holder on and from the date notification of the refusal of the application is given to the permit holder under the Gaming Machine Act.
