Regulations under the *Traffic Act*

AMENDMENT OF TRAFFIC REGULATIONS

SPEED LIMITS

Regulation 50 of the Traffic Regulations is amended -

- (a) by adding at the end of subregulation (1)(a) "or 50 km/h where a notice under subregulation (5) is in force";
- (b) by omitting subregulation (1)(c) and substituting the following:
 - "(c) in a control area -
 - (i) at a speed faster than the speed in km/h indicated by numerals on a Speed Restriction sign at an entrance to the area from a public street; or
 - (ii) in a speed zone in the control area, at a speed faster than the speed in km/h indicated by numerals on a Speed Restriction sign at the beginning of the zone;"

(c) by inserting after subregulation (3) after "60 km/h" the words "or 50 km/h, as the case may be,"; and

(d) by adding at the end the following:

"(5) For the purposes of subregulation (1)(a), the Minister may, by a notice in the *Gazette*, give notice that the speed at which a person may drive a motor vehicle in a municipality or part of a municipality specified in the notice shall not exceed 50 km/h and, on and from the date of the publication of the notice or such later date as is specified in the notice, that speed limit shall apply to the municipality or the part of the municipality."
