Regulations under the Stock Diseases Act

AMENDMENTS OF STOCK DISEASES REGULATIONS

1. REPEAL AND SUBSTITUTION

Regulation 14 of the Stock Diseases Regulations is repealed and the following substituted:

"14. MOVEMENT OF CATTLE

- "(1) Subject to this regulation, where cattle are to be moved from a holding on which they are kept or depastured to an abattoir, saleyard or such other place as the Chief Inspector, for the purpose of this regulation, determines
 - (a) the owner of the holding;
 - (b) where the owner of the holding is not the occupier of the holding - the occupier of the holding; and
 - (c) the owner of the cattle at the time the cattle are moved,

shall, before the cattle are moved, ensure that each animal has been legibly branded in accordance with the $Brands\ Act$ and that -

- (d) where the cattle are ordinarily kept or depastured on that holding - the tail tag; or
- (e) where the cattle are not ordinarily kept or depastured on that holding - a stranger tail tag,

registered under these Regulations in respect of the holding, is affixed to each animal around the tail immediately above the brush.

- "(2) Subregulation (1) does not apply to cattle legibly branded in accordance with the *Brands Act* and moved to an abattoir -
 - (a) in a consignment of 40 or more;
 - (b) from an area in respect of which one tail tag only is registered under these Regulations;
 - (c) separately and apart from cattle from another area in respect of which a tail tag is registered under these Regulations; and
 - (d) from a holding or part of a holding with a disease status of monitored negative, tested negative, confirmed free 2 or confirmed free 3.
- "(3) The Chief Inspector may, by notice in writing, exempt a person either generally or in respect of a particular consignment of stock, from the requirement under subregulation (1) that a tail tag be affixed to stock before the stock is moved from a holding.".

2. REPEAL

Regulation 21 of the Stock Diseases Regulations is repealed.
