Regulations under the Traffic Act

## AMENDMENTS OF TRAFFIC REGULATIONS

1. INTERPRETATION

Regulation 3 of the Traffic Regulations is amended -

- (a) by inserting after the definition of "disabled person's parking bay" the following:
- "'End School Zone sign' means a sign in the form of a Speed Restriction sign or a Speed Derestriction sign on which the words 'END SCHOOL ZONE' have been included;"; and
- "'school day', in relation to a school zone, means a day when students enrolled at a school adjacent to the school zone are, in accordance with the *Education* Act, required to attend at the school;
- "'school zone' means a length of carriageway defined by a School Zone sign at the beginning and an End School Zone sign, a dead end or a terminating carriageway at the end;

"'School Zone sign' means a sign in the form of a Speed Restriction sign on which the words 'SCHOOL ZONE' and the periods of the day during which the sign operates and the words 'SCHOOL DAYS' are included;".

2. LIMITS ON OPERATION OF SIGNS

Regulation 9 of the Traffic Regulations is amended by adding at the end the following:

"(3) A school zone is limited in operation and effect to school days and to the periods of a school day, if any, shown on the School Zone sign associated with the school zone.".

3. OBEDIENCE TO TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNALS

Regulation 12 of the Traffic Regulations is amended by inserting after subregulation (3) the following:

"(3A) Notwithstanding an instruction to the contrary in Table A, where a sign bearing the words "LEFT TURN ON RED PERMITTED AFTER STOPPING" is erected facing a driver on a public street, the driver may, where it is safe to do so and after stopping and giving way to any other vehicle on the public street, turn left.".

4. SPEED LIMITS

Regulation 50(1) of the Traffic Regulations is amended by inserting after paragraph (c) the following:

"(ca) in a school zone at a speed faster than the speed in km/h indicated by numerals on a School Zone sign at the beginning of the zone;".
