AMENDMENTS OF TRAFFIC REGULATIONS

1. POLICE AND OTHER PERSONS EXEMPT FROM CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF ACT AND REGULATIONS

Regulation 7 of the Traffic Regulations is amended by adding at the end the following:

"(3) Section 19(8) of the Act does not apply to a person who is the driver of a motor vehicle referred to in section 19(9)(b) of the Act where -

(a) the person is -

- (i) a member of the Police Force;
- (ii) a member, volunteer member or auxiliary member of the Fire Service of the Northern Territory; or
- (iii) a member, employee or voluntary member of the Northern Territory Emergency Service,

and is driving the motor vehicle in the course of his or her duties as a member, volunteer member, auxiliary member, employee or voluntary member; or

- (b) the person is driving the motor vehicle -
- (i) to a place at which the vehicle is to be used in or the occupants of the vehicle are to take part in;
 - (ii) at a place at which the vehicle is used in or the occupants of the vehicle are taking part in; or
 - (iii) from a place at which the vehicle was used in or the occupants of the vehicle took part in,

a fire management operation within the meaning of the *Motor Vehicles Act* or an operation relating to the control of a bushfire at that place."

2. SCHEDULE 1

Schedule 1 to the Traffic Regulations is amended by -

- (a) omitting from item 26 "section 19(8)" and substituting "section 19(7) or (8)"; and
- (b) adding at the end the following:

"Drive with alcohol in blood
contrary to section 19(6) 100".
