AMENDMENTS OF ALICE SPRINGS (ANIMAL CONTROL) BY-LAWS

1. IDENTIFICATION DEVICE

By-law 13 of the Alice Springs (Animal Control) Bylaws is amended by adding at the end the following:

"(3) Where the identification device issued to the owner of an animal under clause (1) is a subcutaneous implant, the owner shall cause the animal to be implanted with the device by a veterinary surgeon not later than 14 days after the date the animal was registered.".

The common seal of the Alice Springs Town Council was affixed hereto in pursuance of the resolution of the Council passed on 28 June 1993, authorising the seal to be so affixed.
