Regulations under the Liquor Act

I, JAMES HENRY MUIRHEAD, the Administrator of the Northern Territory of Australia, acting with the advice of the Executive Council, hereby make the following Regulations under the Liquor Act.

AMENDMENTS OF THE LIQUOR REGULATIONS

1. COMMENCEMENT AND APPLICATION

These Regulations shall come into operation on 1 March 1992, and, in relation to regulation 2, shall apply in respect of licence fees payable on or after 1 April 1992.

2. PRESCRIBED FEES

Regulation 3(1) of the Liquor Regulations is amended by omitting "2% of the cost into store of liquor containing less than 2.5% by volume of ethyl alcohol," and substituting ", in the case of fees other than fixed sum fees, 7% of the cost into store of liquor containing 3% or less of ethyl alcohol by volume,".

3. DAYS AND TIMES AT WHICH LIQUOR MAY BE SUPPLIED

- (1) Regulation 4(1) of the Liquor Regulations is amended by omitting paragraphs (a) to (d) and substituting the following:
 - "(a) subject to paragraph (d), on Mondays to Fridays (inclusive) between 12 noon and 9.00 p.m.;
 - (b) on Saturdays between 10.00 am and 9.00 p.m.;

- (c) on Sundays between 12.00 noon and 9.00 p.m.;
- (d) on public holidays between 10.00 a.m. and 9.00 p.m., ".
- (2) Notwithstanding subregulation (1), the times applying in relation to a licence referred to in section 35(1)(d) of the Act shall be those times prescribed by regulation 4(1) of the Liquor Regulations immediately before the commencement of this regulation.
