Regulations under the *Police Administration Act*

I, JAMES HENRY MUIRHEAD, the Administrator of the Northern Territory of Australia, acting with the advice of the Executive Council, hereby make the following Regulations under the *Police Administration Act*.

AMENDMENT OF POLICE ADMINISTRATION
(FEES) REGULATIONS

1. COMMENCEMENT

These Regulations shall come into operation on 1 November 1992.

2. REPEAL AND SUBSTITUTION

Regulation 3 of the *Police Administration (Fees) Regulations* and the Schedule to those Regulations are repealed and the following substituted:

"3. OTHER FEES

"(1) The fees specified in Column 2 of the Schedule are fees for the other services (which may be provided by the Police Force) specified in Column 1 of the Schedule.

"(2) A fee shall not be charged for services provided in respect of a sporting or entertainment event except where more than 2 members are present at the event to carry out duties.

Police Administration (Fees) Regulations

"(3) For the purposes of this regulation and the Schedule -

'for each half hour or part thereof' means the period of time during which services are provided in respect of a sporting or entertainment event calculated forward to or back to the nearest half hour;

'services provided in respect of a sporting or entertainment event' means the carrying out of duties by members, or the provision of support services, for and in relation to the holding of a sporting or entertainment event and, in particular, includes -

- (a) policing the area, whether or not an enclosed area, where the event is to take place;
- (b) policing an area designated as a car park, controlling traffic at an entrance to or exit from the event or designated car park and controlling traffic which is using routes specified to be used in relation to the event;
- (c) policing the immediate vicinity outside the area where the event is to take place; and
- (d) planning and administering a strategy in relation to the event;

'sporting or entertainment event' means a sports or other event organised or promoted for the purpose of making a profit except where the Commissioner is satisfied that the whole of any profit is to be applied to a purpose that is charitable, benevolent, philanthropic or beneficial to the community;

'support service' means a police aircraft, a police car, a police horse, a police motorboat, a police motorcycle or a police van provided to enable a member to carry out duties in respect of a sports or entertainment event, but does not include a vehicle used only to transport a member to the area where the member will carry out those duties;

'travelling time' means the period of time reasonably taken -

- (a) by a member to travel from a police station; or

(b) for the transportation or operation of a support service from the place where it is kept,

to the area where services in respect of a sporting or entertainment event will be provided and includes the time reasonably taken to return from that area to the police station or place when the services of the member or support service are no longer required.

"FEES FOR PROVISION OF OTHER SERVICES

Column 1 Services	Column 2 Fee
1. Provision of an escort	\$22.00 for each half hour or part thereof for each member engaged (but the minimum fee shall not be less than for 2 hours)
2. Performance of special guard duty	\$22.00 for each half hour or part thereof for each member engaged
3. Provision of services for the purposes of a sporting or entertainment event -	
(a) where a member who holds a rank above the rank of senior sergeant carries out duties	\$33.00 for each half hour or part thereof (including travelling time) for each member engaged
(b) where a member who holds the rank of senior sergeant or sergeant carries out duties	\$25.00 for each half hour or part thereof (including travelling time) for each member engaged
(c) where a member who holds a rank below the rank of sergeant carries out duties	\$22.00 for each half hour or part thereof (including travelling time) for each member engaged

4. Where the provision of services for the purposes of a sporting or entertainment event requires the provision of support services -
 - (a) for a police horse \$2.50 for each half hour or part thereof (including travelling time) for each horse
 - (b) for a police motorcycle \$7.50 for each half hour or part thereof (including travelling time) for each motorcycle
 - (c) for a police car or van \$10.00 for each half hour or part thereof (including travelling time) for each car or van
 - (d) for a police motor boat being -
 - (i) a single engine motor boat \$15.00 for each half hour or part thereof (including travelling time) for each motor boat
 - (ii) a twin engine motor boat \$75.00 for each half hour or part thereof (including travelling time) for each motor boat
 - (e) for a police aircraft \$250.00 for each half hour or part thereof (including travelling time) for each aircraft
5. For the interviewing of a member for the purpose of acquiring information in relation to an accident \$22.00 for each half hour or part thereof for each member interviewed
6. Provision of a report in respect of an accident \$17.00 and, in addition, 50c for each copy of a page of the report
7. Provision of a report in respect of stolen property \$17.00 and, in addition, 50c for each copy of a page of the report
8. Provision of a report for the purposes of granting a passport or visa \$17.00 where a search of police finger-print files is not required or \$30.00 where a search of police finger-print files is required

9. Provision of photographic services - \$17.00 and, in addition -
- (a) for a black and white photographic print size -
- (i) 17 cm x 12 cm \$ 5.75
 - (ii) 25 cm x 20 cm \$10.35
 - (iii) 50 cm x 40 cm \$45.85
- (b) for a coloured photograph print size -
- (i) 10.4 cm x 15.2 cm \$ 0.90
 - (ii) 20.8 cm x 15.2 cm \$ 4.35
 - (iii) 25 cm x 20 cm \$ 9.10
 - (iv) 50.8 cm x 40.6 cm \$40.00
- (c) for the development of a negative \$ 6.80
- (d) for a copy of a photograph \$ 8.80
- (e) for any other photographic work the current market price as determined by the member in charge of the forensic science section of the Police Force
