## AMENDMENT OF GREYHOUND RACING RULES

## WITHDRAWAL BY OWNER OR TRAINER

Rule 210 of the Greyhound Racing Rules is amended by inserting after subrule (1) the following:

- "(1A) An application to withdraw a greyhound from a race shall be made by the owner or trainer of the greyhound to the stewards before 9.30 o'clock in the morning on the day of the race unless the condition of the greyhound causing its inability to compete in the race is not evident before that time.
- "(1B) The owner or trainer of a greyhound who contravenes or fails to comply with subrule (1A) is punishable upon the offence being proved, in accordance with these Rules, by a fine not exceeding \$500.".
