Regulations 1991, No. 21*

Regulations under the Trade Measurement Administration Act

I, JAMES HENRY MUIRHEAD, the Administrator of the Northern Territory of Australia, acting with the advice of the Executive Council, hereby make the following Regulations under the *Trade Measurement Administration Act*.

TRADE MEASUREMENT (CHARGES AND FEES) REGULATIONS

1. CITATION

These Regulations may be cited as the Trade Measurement (Charges and Fees) Regulations 1991.

2. CHARGES IN RESPECT OF VERIFICATION AND RE-VERIFICATION OF MEASURING INSTRUMENTS

(1) Subject to regulation 5, the charge payable under section 7(1) of the Act in respect of the verification or re-verification of a measuring instrument is that specified in the right hand column of the Schedule opposite the relevant descriptive entry in the left hand column of the Schedule.

(2) Where an inspector's examination or testing of a measuring instrument for the purposes of verification or re-verification is at the request of the person who is the owner of the instrument within the meaning of section 7 of the Act -

 (a) there shall, if the Superintendent requires payment thereof by notice in writing served on the person, be payable by the person (in addition to the charge payable under section

7(1)) a charge of an amount specified in the notice in respect of the inspector's travel to and from the place where the measuring instrument was examined or tested; and

- (b) subject to regulation 5, the amount of the charge shall be an amount equal to -
 - (i) 44 cents for each km or part so travelled by the inspector; and
 - (ii) \$50.00 for each hour of travel, and pro rata for any period of travel less than one hour.
- (3) Subject to regulation 5, where an inspector -
- (a) keeps an appointment to examine or test a measuring instrument for the purposes of verification or re-verification; and
- (b) is unable to carry out the examination or testing because the instrument is unavailable or inaccessible, or because access to it is unreasonably refused,

there shall be payable by the person by or on whose behalf the appointment was made a charge of \$100.00.

3. CHARGE FOR HIRE OF TEST MASSES

Subject to regulation 5, there shall be payable by a person who hires test masses from the Superintendent -

- (a) where the period of hire does not exceed 5 days
 a charge for each day or part of a day of \$5.00 per tonne or part of a tonne; and
- (b) where the period of hire exceeds 5 days a charge for each day or part of a day in excess of 5 of \$20.00 per tonne or part of a tonne.

4. LICENCE FEES

Subject to regulation 5 -

- (a) the fee for a licence is \$100.00 for the period of 12 months beginning with the date on which the licence is granted, and \$100.00 for each subsequent period of 12 months; and
- (b) the fee for an amended licence or duplicate licence is \$100.00.

5. ANNUAL ADJUSTMENT OF CHARGES AND FEES

(1) For the years beginning 1 October 1992 and each subsequent 1 October, these Regulations shall have effect as if -

- (a) in the case of the year beginning 1 October 1992, for each amount specified as -
 - (i) the amount of a charge or fee; or
 - (ii) an amount by reference to which a charge is to be calculated,

there were substituted that amount as adjusted in accordance with subregulation (2); and

(b) in the case of a subsequent year, for each amount substituted for the preceding year there were substituted that amount as adjusted in accordance with subregulation (2).

(2) An amount to which subregulation (1) applies shall be adjusted -

- (a) by increasing or reducing that amount ("the starting amount") by the same percentage as the relevant percentage change in the Consumer Price Index;
- (b) by increasing the resulting amount by 2% of the starting amount; and
- (c) by rounding up the then resulting amount to the nearest amount that is 5 cents or a multiple of 5 cents.

(3) For the purposes of subregulation (2)(a), the relevant percentage change in the Consumer Price Index is the change published by the Australian Bureau of Statistics as the percentage change in that Index (All groups - Weighted average of 8 capital cities) between the 4 quarters ending with the June quarter preceding the adjustment.

6. CHARGES AND FEES AS ADJUSTED TO BE GAZETTED

The Minister shall, as soon as practicable after 1 October 1992 and each subsequent 1 October, publish in the *Gazette* a notice showing the amounts which, by virtue of regulation 5, are to be treated as specified in these Regulations as they have effect for the year beginning on the 1 October in question.
