AMENDMENTS OF SPECIAL PURPOSES LEASES REGULATIONS

1. COMMENCEMENT

These Regulations shall come into operation on the commencement of the Real Property (Consequential Amendments) Act.

2. NEW REGULATION

The Special Purposes Leases Regulations are amended by inserting after regulation 8 the following:

"9. FORM FOR THE PURPOSE OF SECTION 5AA

"For the purposes of section 5AA of the Act, a form lodged under that section shall be in accordance with Form 3.".

3. SCHEDULE
