AMENDMENTS OF JUSTICES REGULATIONS

1. COMMENCEMENT

These Regulations shall come into operation on the commencement of the *Justices Amendment Act 1991*.

2. SCHEDULE

The Schedule to the *Justices Regulations* is amended -

- (a) by omitting in Forms 66, 67 and 69 "within the meaning of section 100AB" and substituting "within the meaning of section 100AA"; and
- (b) by omitting Form 68 and substituting the following:
