Regulations under the Traffic Act

AMENDMENTS OF THE TRAFFIC REGULATIONS

1. PRINCIPAL REGULATIONS

The Traffic Regulations are in these Regulations referred to as the Principal Regulations.

2. INTERPRETATION

Regulation 3(1) of the Principal Regulations is amended by inserting after the definition of "bicycle way" the following:

"'box trailer' means a small trailer -

- (a) the unladen mass of which does not exceed 500 kg; or
- (b) the laden mass of which is not capable of, or is unlikely to exceed, 1 tonne; ".

3. PARTICULARS TO BE SHOWN ON TRAFFIC INFRINGEMENT NOTICE

Regulation 88(1)(f) of the Principal Regulations is amended by omitting all words after "in the notice" and substituting "within the time specified in the notice, no further action will be taken unless a notice is given by a member of the Police Force that the traffic infringement notice has been withdrawn; and".

4. SCHEDULE

Schedule 1 to the Principal Regulations is repealed and the following substituted:
