AMENDMENT OF THE POLICE ADMINISTRATION REGULATIONS

SAVINGS AND TRANSITIONAL

The Police Administration Regulations are amended by inserting after regulation 8(2) of Regulations 1985, No. 33 the following:

"(3) A member who, immediately before the commencement of Regulations 1990 No. 34 held the rank of Sergeant Second Class by virtue of subregulation (1)(b) shall, on the commencement of Regulation 1990 No. 34 hold the rank of Senior Sergeant but shall not be qualified for promotion to a rank above Senior Sergeant until, in addition to any other qualifications he or she might require for promotion to that higher rank, the member has passed the qualifying examination for the promotion of a member to the rank of Senior Sergeant.".
