Regulations under the Liquor Act

AMENDMENT OF LIQUOR REGULATIONS

The Liquor Regulations are amended by inserting after regulation 5 the following:

"6. PRESCRIBED PERIOD

"For the purposes of the definition of 'cost into store' in respect of a licence referred to in section 35(1)(c) of the Act, the prescribed period is any licence period preceding the licence period in respect of which a licence fee is due and payable which is in the same financial year as that licence period.

"7. PRESCRIBED MANNER FOR CALCULATING LICENCE FEE FOR LICENCE REFERRED TO IN SECTION 35(1)(C)

"The licence fee for a licence period in respect of a licence referred to in section 35(1)(c) of the Act shall be calculated in accordance with regulation 3 and item 3 of the Schedule, and the amount so calculated shall be reduced by the amount of any licence fee paid under the licence in respect of any licence period which is in the same financial year as the licence period in respect of which the fee is calculated.".
