AMENDMENTS OF THE PORT BY-LAWS

1. COMMENCEMENT

These By-laws shall come into operation on 1 February 1989.

2. NEW BY-LAW

The Port By-laws are amended by inserting after by-law 53A the following.

"53B. QUARANTINE WASTE DISPOSAL FEES

"The master or owner of a vessel who, in accordance with regulation 33C of the Quarantine (General) Regulations of the Commonwealth, is required to make available for collection all animal waste, organic refuse, galley scraps or waste from the vessel shall pay the fee specified in Schedule 7 for the removal and disposal of that waste, refuse or scraps for each day that the vessel remains in the Port of Darwin.".

3. NEW SCHEDULE

The Port By-laws are amended by inserting after Schedule 6 the following:

"SCHEDULE 7

By-law 53B

QUARANTINE WASTE DISPOSAL FEE

Fee for the disposal of waste from a vessel of -

- (a) less than 25 metres in length nil.
- (b) 25 metres or more in length \$30.00 plus \$2.00 for each person on board, for each day or part of a day, subject to a daily maximum of \$1,000.00.".
