AMENDMENTS OF THE NURSING REGULATIONS

1. REPEAL AND SUBSTITUTION

Regulation 16 of the Nursing Regulations is repealed and the following substituted:

"16. PRESCRIBED COURSES OF STUDY FOR GENERAL NURSING

The prescribed courses of study for general nursing are -

- (a) a course at a school of general nursing for at least 3 years in which the subjects specified in Schedule 1 are covered for the number of hours appearing opposite the subject, the clinical experience specified in Schedule 2 is obtained and the skills specified in Part 1 of Schedule 3 are mastered in accordance with Part 2 of that Schedule; or
- (b) the course of study provided by the Northern Territory University for the Diploma of Applied Science (Nursing).".

2. REPEAL

Regulation 17 of the Nursing Regulations is repealed.

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3. EXAMINATIONS

Regulation 23 of the Nursing Regulations is amended by omitting subregulation (1) and substituting the following:

"(1) For the purposes of sections 12(2) and 13(c) of the Act -

- (a) an examination in accordance with this regulation; or
- (b) an examination set by the Northern Territory University in relation to the course of study for the Diploma of Applied Science (Nursing),

is a prescribed examination.".
