Regulations 1988, No. 29*

By-laws under the *University College of the Northern Territory Act*

The Council of the University College of the Northern Territory, in pursuance of section 43 of the *University College of the Northern Territory Act* and the approval of the Council at a meeting held on 4 March 1988, hereby makes the following By-laws.

UNIVERSITY COLLEGE OF THE NORTHERN TERRITORY

AMENDMENT TO THE BY-LAW GOVERNING EXCLUSION

Section (1)(a) is repealed and the following substituted:

"the grade point average for subjects in which the student enrolled in the last semester of enrolment and in which credit could have been obtained is less than 2.5 and the subjects in which a pass was not achieved within the last 10 years have a total credit point value of 25 or more;"

The Common Seal of the University College of the Northern Territory was affixed hereto on the sixteenth day of May 1988, in pursuance of a resolution of the Council authorising the Common Seal to be so affixed, passed on the fourth day of March 1988.
