AMENDMENT OF THE ABATTOIRS AND SLAUGHTERING REGULATIONS

NEW REGULATION

The Abattoirs and Slaughtering Regulations are amended by inserting after regulation 3 the following:

"3A. CERTAIN ANIMALS PRESCRIBED TO BE STOCK

"For the purposes of the Act, asses, camels, hinnies, horses and mules are prescribed as stock.".
