AMENDMENTS OF STOCK DISEASES REGULATIONS

1. DEFINITIONS

Regulation 3 of the Stock Diseases Regulations is amended by inserting after the definition of "abattoir" the following:

"'cattle' includes buffalo;".

2. FORM E OF SCHEDULE 2

Form E of Schedule 2 of the Stock Diseases Regulations is amended -

(a) by omitting paragraphs B and C and substituting the following:
