Regulations under the Motor Vehicles Act

AMENDMENTS OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES (FEES AND CHARGES) REGULATIONS

1. COMMENCEMENT

These Regulations shall come into operation on 1 January 1989.

2. NEW REGULATION

The Motor Vehicles (Fees and Charges) Regulations are amended by inserting after regulation 2 the following:

"2A. DEFINITIONS

"In these Regulations -

'classic', in relation to a motor vehicle, means of a kind that was manufactured after 31 December 1930 but which is more than 30 years old;

'veteran', in relation to a motor vehicle, means of a kind manufactured before 1 January 1919;

Motor Vehicles (Fees and Charges) Regulations

'vintage', in relation to a motor vehicle, means of a kind manufactured after 31 December 1918 but before 1 January 1931.".

3. SCHEDULE

The Schedule to the motor vehicles (Fees and Charges) Regulations is amended -

(a) by omitting from the column headed "Description of fee or charge" opposite item 1 all words before paragraph (a) and substituting the following:

"Registration or renewal of registration of all motor vehicles or trailers (other than motor vehicles in respect of which another fee is provided by this Schedule):"

; and

- (b) by inserting after item 1 the following:
- "1A A vintage, veteran or 13(1) classic motor vehicle:
 - (a) being a motor cycle \$5.00
 - (b) not being a motor cycle \$25.00
- "1B A powered wheelchair capable 13(1) \$5.00 of travelling at a speed exceeding 7 km/h
