By-laws under the University College of the Northern Territory Act

The Council of the University College of the Northern Territory, in pursuance of section 43 of the University College of the Northern Territory Act and the approval of the Council at meetings held on 17 February and 13 April, 1986, hereby makes the following By-laws.

UNIVERSITY COLLEGE OF THE NORTHERN TERRITORY

BY-LAWS GOVERNING THE USE AND CUSTODY OF THE COMMON SEAL

1. CUSTODY OF COMMON SEAL

The Common Seal of the College shall be and remain in the custody of the Chairman and the Registrar and shall not be affixed to any document except pursuant to a resolution of Council.

2. AFFIXING OF COMMON SEAL

That authority be given to the following officers of the University College to affix the Common Seal of the University College to documents as specified in the case of the officer concerned:

(a) the Warden or the Registrar -

 (i) in any case where an investment of University College moneys or a sale or other dealing with University College property has been approved by a proper authority of the University College, and a document connected therewith is required to be executed under the Seal of the University College;

- (ii) to any other document the execution of which under the Common Seal of the University College has been approved by the proper authority of the University College;
- (b) the Registrar, or any other authorised officer who carries out the procedures for promulgation of a By-law made by Council, to any certificate verifying the due promulgation of that By-law.
