Regulations 1987, No. 16*

By-laws under the *Local Government Act*

The Darwin City Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by the *Local Government Act* and in accordance with section 204(2) and (3) of the Act, at a meeting held on the seventeenth day of December, 1986, hereby makes the following By-laws.

AMENDMENTS TO THE BY-LAWS OF THE
MUNICIPALITY OF DARWIN

1. NEW BY-LAWS

The By-laws of the Municipality of Darwin are amended by inserting after by-law 22.33 the following:

"22.33A ANIMALS ON FORESHORE

"(1) The Council may, by notice in a newspaper circulating in the Municipality, declare an area of the foreshore to be an area onto which an animal of a kind specified in the notice may not be taken or permitted to enter or remain or may not enter or remain except in accordance with conditions, if any, specified in the notice.

"(2) The Council shall cause a sign to be erected at a prominent place on, or at the approaches to, an area declared under clause (1) containing the information in the notice of declaration under that clause.

"22.33B ANIMALS NOT TO BE ALLOWED INTO AREA

"A person who brings onto or allows to be brought onto or remain on an area declared under by-law 22.33A(1) an animal of a kind specified in the notice of the declaration, except in accordance with the conditions, if any, specified in the notice, is guilty of an offence.

Municipality of Darwin By-law Amendment

"22.33C REMOVAL OF ANIMALS

"(1) An officer may remove from an area declared under by-law 22.33A(1), or direct a person in charge of the animal to remove from the area within the time specified by the officer, an animal not permitted to enter or remain on the area or which enters or remains on the area in contravention of a condition in a notice under that by-law.

"(2) A person who refuses or fails to comply with a direction under clause (1) is guilty of an offence.

"(3) A person who hinders or obstructs an officer in the exercise of the officer's powers under clause (1) is guilty of an offence."
