Regulations 1987, No. 19*

Regulations under the *Local Government Act*

The Nguiu Community Government Council, in pursuance of section 292(1) of the *Local Government Act*, at a meeting held on the 27th day of March, 1987, made the following By-laws and, for the purposes of section 63(2)(a) of the *Interpretation Act*, authorized Stanley Tipiloura, its President, to sign them.

NGUIU COMMUNITY GOVERNMENT COUNCIL
(COMMON SEAL) BY-LAWS

1. CITATION

These By-laws may be cited as the Nguiu Community Government Council (Common Seal) By-laws.

2. DEFINITION

In these By-laws, "common seal" means the common seal referred to in clause 5 of the Nguiu Community Government Scheme.

3. CUSTODY OF COMMON SEAL

(1) The common seal shall be kept at the Council offices under the care and control of the clerk.

(2) The clerk shall ensure that, except when the common seal is in use, it is kept in the Council's safe or a fireproof cabinet.

4. USE OF COMMON SEAL

(1) Subject to clause (2), the common seal shall be used only by resolution of the Council.

(2) Where the Council, by resolution, resolves to enter into a contract or agreement, the resolution is authority for the affixing of the common seal to the contract or agreement or any other document relating to that contract or agreement.

5. AFFIXING OF COMMON SEAL

Where the common seal is affixed in pursuance of by-law 4, it shall be witnessed by the President and clerk and attested in accordance with the Schedule.

6. REGISTER OF USE OF SEAL

(1) The clerk shall maintain a register to record details of the use of the common seal.

(2) Where the common seal is affixed to a document, the clerk shall enter details of the use of the common seal in the register maintained under clause (1) and the persons who witnessed the affixing of the common seal shall sign the register.

7. IMPRESSIONS OF COMMON SEAL

(1) A person shall not use the common seal except in accordance with these By-laws.

(2) A person shall not take an impression or use a facsimile of the common seal without the express authority of the Council.

Penalty for an offence against this by-law: \$20.
