Regulations under the Criminal Investigation (Extra-territorial Offences) Act

CRIMINAL INVESTIGATION (EXTRA-TERRITORIAL OFFENCES) REGULATIONS

1. CITATION

These Regulations may be cited as the Criminal Investigation (Extra-territorial Offences) Regulations.

2. COMMENCEMENT

These Regulations shall come into operation 14 days after notification in the *Gazette*.

3. FORMS OF SEARCH WARRANT

(1) Where an application for the issue of a search warrant has been made personally, a search warrant issued shall be in accordance with Form 1 in the Schedule.

(2) Where an application for the issue of a search warrant has been made by telephone, a search warrant issued shall be in accordance with Form 2 in the Schedule.

4. FORM OF NOTICE OF SEIZURE

Where in the execution of a search warrant objects have been seized and removed, notice of the seizure and removal shall be given in accordance with Form 3 in the Schedule.
