Regulations under the *Police Administration Act*

AMENDMENTS OF THE POLICE ADMINISTRATION
(FEES) REGULATIONS

1. COMMENCEMENT

These Regulations shall come into operation at the expiration of 14 days from the date on which the making of the Regulations is notified in the *Gazette*.

2. PRINCIPAL REGULATIONS

The Police Administration (Fees) Regulations are in these Regulations referred to as the Principal Regulations.

3. NEW REGULATION

The Principal Regulations are amended by inserting after regulation 2 the following:

"2A. FEE FOR POLICE ATTENDANCE AT FALSE ALARMS

"(1) Subject to subregulations (2) and (3), where the police have attended any premises in response to a false alarm on 3 occasions in a period of 28 days, an attendance fee of \$100 shall, on each subsequent occasion on which they so attend the premises, be payable by the occupier of the premises or, if they are unoccupied, by their owner, and shall be recoverable as a debt due and payable to the Territory.

"(2) Where in the case of any premises a period of 90 days passes during which the police have not attended them in response to a false alarm, all previous occasions on which the police have attended the premises shall be disregarded for the purposes of subregulation (1).

"(3) A fee shall not become payable under subregulation (1) if the Commissioner so decides in the circumstances of a particular case.

"(4) For the purposes of this regulation, the police are to be treated as attending premises in response to a false alarm where a member of the Police Force attends them in the course of his duty and in response to an alarm which was installed for the protection of the premises and was, in the opinion of the member responsible for the investigation of the incident, activated otherwise than by a person's unlawful conduct."

4. OTHER FEES

Regulation 3 of the Principal Regulations is amended by omitting ", other than the fee referred to in Regulation 2, specified in the Schedule are the fees" and substituting "specified in the Schedule are".

5. SCHEDULE

The Schedule to the Principal Regulations is amended by omitting items 5 and 6 and substituting the following:

"5. photography services	\$13 service charge plus -
(i) for a photographic print (colour)	17 cm x 12 cm - \$5.45 25 cm x 20 cm - \$9.10 50 cm x 40 cm - \$20.00
