AMENDMENT OF MINES SAFETY CONTROL REGULATIONS

NEW REGULATION

The Mines Safety Control Regulations are amended by adding after regulation 42A the following:

"42B. DECLARATION OF AREA OF SILICOSIS RISK

- "(1) Subject to subregulation (2), the Chief Government Mining Engineer may, by notice in writing served on the manager, declare a mine or a part of a mine to be an area of silicosis risk for the purposes of the Silicosis and Tuberculosis (Mine-Workers and Prospectors) Act.
- "(2) Where, under subregulation (1), the Chief Government Mining Engineer declares a mine or part of a mine to be an area of silicosis risk, he shall, as soon as practicable after making the declaration, notify the Chief Medical Officer within the meaning of the Public Health Act.

Mines Safety Control Regulations

- "(3) A manager served with a notice under subregulation (1) shall $\,$
 - (a) enter particulars of the notice in the Record Book; and
 - (b) notify all persons employed in the mine or the part of the mine, as the case may be, that it is an area of silicosis risk for the purposes of the Silicosis and Tuberculosis (Mine-Workers and Prospectors) Act.".
