AMENDMENT OF THE LIQUOR REGULATIONS

REPEAL AND SUBSTITUTION

Regulation 4 of the Liquor Regulations is repealed and the following substituted:

"4. DAYS AND TIMES AT WHICH LIQUOR MAY BE SUPPLIED

"(1) The Commission shall not issue a licence to a licensee authorizing him to supply liquor for consumption away from the premises at a time other than the following:

- (a) subject to paragraph (d), on Mondays to Fridays (inclusive) - between 12.00 noon and 10.00 p.m.;

- (b) on Saturdays - between 9.00 a.m. and 10.00 p.m.;
- (c) on Sundays - between 12.00 noon and 10.00 p.m.;  
and
- (d) on public holidays - between 9.00 a.m. and  
10.00 p.m..

"(2) In this regulation, 'public holidays' means public holidays observed in the Territory pursuant to sections 5 and 6 of the *Public Holidays Act*, but does not include Good Friday."
