### AMENDMENT OF THE LIQUOR REGULATIONS

#### REPEAL AND SUBSTITUTION

Regulation 4 of the Liquor Regulations is repealed and the following substituted:

- "4. DAYS AND TIMES AT WHICH LIQUOR MAY BE SUPPLIED
- "(1) The Commission shall not issue a licence to a licensee authorizing him to supply liquor for consumption away from the premises at a time other than the following:
  - subject to paragraph (d), on Mondays to Fridays (inclusive) between 12.00 noon and 10.00 p.m.;

- (b) on Saturdays between 9.00 a.m. and 10.00 p.m.;
- (c) on Sundays between 12.00 noon and 10.00 p.m.;
- (d) on public holidays between 9.00 a.m. and 10.00~p.m..
- "(2) In this regulation, 'public holidays' means public holidays observed in the Territory pursuant to sections 5 and 6 of the *Public Holidays Act*, but does not include Good Friday.".
