AMENDMENTS OF THE LIQUOR REGULATIONS

1. COMMENCEMENT

These Regulations shall come into operation on 1 July 1985.

2. REPEAL AND SUBSTITUTION

Regulation 3 of the Liquor Regulations is repealed and the following substituted:

"3. PRESCRIBED FEES

"The fees calculated as set out in the Schedule, less 2% of the cost into store of liquor containing less than 2.5% by volume of ethyl alcohol, are the relevant prescribed fees for the purposes of the Act.".

3. SCHEDULE

The Schedule to the Liquor Regulations is amended -

- (a) by omitting from item 1 "12% and substituting "16%;
- (b) by omitting from item 2 "5%" and "9%" and substituting "7%" and "11%" respectively;
- (c) by omitting from item 3 "4%", "5%" and "7%" and substituting "6%", "7%" and "9%" respectively;
- (d) by omitting from item 5 "5%" and substituting "7%".
