MARINE (SMALL CRAFT) REGULATIONS

1. CITATION

These Regulations may be cited as the Marine (Small Craft) Regulations.

2. CLOSURE OF NORTHERN TERRITORY WATERS

(1) The Minister may, by notice in the *Gazette*, declare, for the purposes of holding a regatta, competition, carnival or other event, except an owner of a small craft whose entry has been accepted by the persons holding the regatta, competition, carnival or other event, for a period of not more than 48 hours, any Northern Territory waters to be closed to any other small craft.

*Marine (Small Craft) Regulations*

(2) A member of the Police Force may prevent a small craft from entering or remove a small craft from any Northern Territory waters which have been, by a notice under sub-regulation (1), closed.

(3) A person, other than the owner of a small craft whose entry has been accepted by the persons holding a regatta, competition, carnival or other event, shall not navigate a small craft in Northern Territory waters which have been, by a notice under sub-regulation (1), closed.

Penalty: \$1,000.
