Regulations under the Fish and Fisheries Act

AMENDMENTS OF THE FISH AND FISHERIES REGULATIONS

1. COMMENCEMENT

These Regulations shall come into operation at the expiration of 14 days from the date on which the making of the Regulations is notified in the *Gazette*.

2. PRINCIPAL REGULATIONS

The Fish and Fisheries Regulations are in these Regulations referred to as the Principal Regulations.

3. DEFINITIONS

Regulation 3 of the Principal Regulations is amended by inserting in the definition of "sedentary organism" after "Commonwealth" the words "and include a sedentary organism that is dead".

4. NEW REGULATION

The Principal Regulations are amended by adding after regulation 59 in Division 3 of Part VI the following:

"59A. EAST POINT REEF FISH RESERVE

"Subject to section 94 of the Act, a person shall not - $\,$

- (a) use any item of fishing gear other than -
 - (i) rod and line and attachments; or
 - (ii) handline and attachments, to fish for or take fish:
- (b) take fish less than 30 centimetres in length; or
- (c) take or remove any sedentary organisms, in the East Point Reef Fish Reserve.

Penalty: \$1,000.".
