ALICE SPRINGS TELEGRAPH STATION HISTORICAL RESERVE (CLOSURE) BY-LAWS

1. EXPIRATION OF BY-LAWS

These By-laws shall expire on 22 March, 1983.

2. CLOSURE OF RESERVE

Notwithstanding anything contained in any other By-law under this Act, no person shall, on 21 March 1983, enter or remain on the Alice Springs Telegraph Station Historical Reserve (formally called the Alice Springs Telegraph Station National Park) declared on 30 June, 1978, under section 12 of the Act, to be a reserve, except with and in accordance with the authority of the Commission.
