AMENDMENTS OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH  
(BARBERS' SHOPS) REGULATIONS

1. COMMENCEMENT

These Regulations shall come into operation on the commencement of the Public Health Amendment Act 1981.

2. BARBERS TO HOLD CERTIFICATES THAT THEY ARE NOT  
SUFFERING FROM TUBERCULOSIS

Regulation 19(3) of the Public Health (Barbers' Shops) Regulations is amended by omitting "An inspector" and substituting "A Health Surveyor".

3. PUBLIC INSPECTION AND EXAMINATION OF EQUIPMENT

Regulation 22 of the Public Health (Barbers' Shops) Regulations is amended by omitting "an Inspector" and substituting "a Health Surveyor".
