AMENDMENTS OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH (GENERAL SANITATION, MOSQUITO PREVENTION, RAT EXCLUSION AND PREVENTION) REGULATIONS

1. COMMENCEMENT

These Regulations shall come into operation on the commencement of the Public Health Amendment Act 1981.

2. DEFINITIONS

Regulation 3 of the Public Health (General Sanitation, Mosquito Prevention, Rat Exclusion and Prevention) Regulations is amended -

- (a) by omitting "an inspector of health" from the definition of "Inspector" and substituting "a Health Surveyor"; and
- (b) by omitting "inspector" (second occurring) from the definition of "Inspector" and substituting "Health Surveyor".
