AMENDMENTS OF THE PRISONS (CORRECTIONAL SERVICES) REGULATIONS

ENFORCEMENT OF PENALTIES

Regulation 3 of the Prisons (Correctional Services) Regulations is amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

- "(3) At any time after a decision or order of the Director under section 31 of the Act imposing a penalty on a prisoner, the prisoner may elect that the penalty imposed upon him be enforced as soon as the Director thinks fit.
- "(4) Where a prisoner elects under sub-regulation (3) that the penalty imposed upon him be enforced as soon as the Director thinks fit -
 - (a) the Director may enforce the penalty as soon as he thinks fit, notwithstanding sub-regulation (1) or (2); and
 - (b) an appeal under section 37 of the Act in respect of the decision or order imposing the penalty is void ab initio.".
