Regulations 1982, No. 36*

LIQUOR (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS

1. COMMENCEMENT

These Regulations shall come into force on a date to be fixed by the Administrator by notice in the *Gazette*.

2. NEW REGULATIONS

The Liquor Regulations are amended by adding after regulation 3 the following:

"4. DAYS AND TIMES AT WHICH LIQUOR MAY BE SUPPLIED

"Subject to regulation 5, the Commission shall not issue a licence to a licensee authorizing him to supply liquor for consumption away from the premises at a time other than the following:

- (a) on Mondays to Fridays (inclusive) - between 12.00 noon and 9.00 p.m.;
- (b) on Saturdays - between 9.00 a.m. and 9.00 p.m.;
and
- (c) on Sundays - between 12.00 noon and 9.00 p.m.

Liquor (Amendment)

"5. EXEMPTIONS

"(1) The Commission may authorize a licensee to supply liquor for consumption away from the premises outside the prescribed hours where it is satisfied that -

- (a) the liquor sold outside the prescribed hours is not likely to be consumed in a public place; and
- (b) the sale of liquor outside the prescribed hours is not likely to lead to public drunkenness.

"(2) Where the Commission has authorized a licensee to supply liquor outside the prescribed hours for consumption away from the premises, it shall cause his licence to be endorsed accordingly.

"(3) In this regulation -

"the prescribed hours" means the times mentioned in regulation 4(1)(a), (b) and (c);

"public place" means a public place within the meaning of the *Summary Offences Act* which is within 2 kilometres of the licensed premises from which the liquor is supplied."
