AMENDMENTS OF THE LEGAL PRACTITIONERS REGULATIONS

1. COMMENCEMENT

These Regulations shall come into operation on 1 October 1982.

2. NEW REGULATIONS

The Legal Practitioners Regulations are amended -

(a) by inserting after regulation 1 the following:

"1A. ADMISSION FEES

"For the purposes of section 14A(1) of the Act, all applicants for admission are in one class and the admission fee in respect of that class is \$75."; and

(b) by inserting after regulation 2 the following:

"3. PRACTISING CERTIFICATE FEES

"For the purposes of section 32(1) of the Act, the prescribed amount is -

- (a) for an unrestricted practising certificate where the applicant is not a visiting counsel, \$300;
 - (b) for an unrestricted practising certificate where the applicant is a visiting counsel, \$100; and
 - (c) for a restricted practising certificate, \$50."
