TEACHING SERVICE REGULATIONS

1. CITATION

These Regulations may be cited as the Teaching Service Regulations.

2. DIRECTIONS TO BE GAZETTED

For the purposes of section 23(5) of the Act, where the Commissioner gives a direction under section 23(3) or (4) of the Act, the direction shall be made known by the publication of that direction in the Gazette, not later than 28 days after the making of that direction.

3. TEMPORARY VACANCIES

(1) For the purposes of section 25(4) of the Act and subject to sub-regulation (2), the Secretary may fill a vacant position by the temporary promotion or temporary transfer of an officer or employee to fill the vacant position.

Teaching Service Regulations

(2) Where a temporary promotion or temporary transfer under sub-regulation (1) of an officer or employee to fill a vacant position is expected to be for a period of 6 months or longer, the vacancy shall be notified in such manner as the Commissioner directs.

4. PROVISIONAL PROMOTION OF OFFICERS

Where an officer is temporarily promoted under regulation 3(1) to fill a vacant position and the temporary promotion is expected to be for a period of 6 months or longer, that temporary promotion is provisional and is subject to appeal in the same manner as provided by section 28 of the Act, as if that promotion were a promotion made under section 25(1)(c) of the Act.

5. TENURE

- (1) For the purposes of section 38(3) of the Act, the minimum prescribed age is 55 years.
- (2) For the purposes of section 38(4) of the Act, the maximum prescribed age is 65 years.

6. NOTICE OF RESIGNATION

For the purposes of section 38(6) of the Act, the period of notice is 28 days.
