AMENDMENTS TO THE POLICE ADMINISTRATION  
REGULATIONS

The Police Administration Regulations are amended by inserting after regulation 18 the following regulation:

"18A.(1) A member who obtains not less than 60 per cent on the maximum number of possible marks in a section of an examination shall be credited with a pass in that section.

"(2) A member who has been credited with a pass in one section, but not all sections, of an examination (including an examination held before the commencement of these Regulations) may, during the currency of that credit, sit for the sections in respect of which he has not been credited with a pass without also sitting for the section in respect of which he has been credited with a pass.

"(3) A credit gained by a member in accordance with sub-regulation (1) or in accordance with the Police Regulations shall lapse if, at either of the 2 relevant examinations next held after the examination in respect of which the credit was gained, that member is not credited with a pass in respect of those sections of the examination in which he has previously failed to obtain a pass."
