CITATION

These Regulations may be cited as the Firearms Regulations.

2. PRESCRIBED FEE FOR REGISTRATION OF A FIREARM

- (1) For the purposes of section 13(2)(b) of the <u>Firearms Act</u>, the prescribed fee for an application for a certificate of registration in respect of a firearm is \$5.00.
- (2) Where 3 or more firearms are presented for registration at the same time, the Commissioner may waive a fee prescribed by subregulation (1) in respect of the third and subsequent firearm.

3. PRESCRIBED FEE FOR LICENCE OR PERMIT

- (1) For the purposes of section 19(b) of the Firearms Act, the prescribed fee for an application for -
 - (a) a dealers licence is \$20.00;
 - (b) an armourer's licence is \$10.00;

- (c) a collector's licence is \$20.00;
- (d) a shooter's licence in relation to firearms class A is \$12.00;
- (e) a shooter's licence in relation to firearms class B is \$20.00;
- (f) a shooter's licence in relation to firearms class C is \$20.00;
- (g) a shooter's licence in relation to firearms class D is \$20.00; and
- (h) a temporary permit is \$2.00.

4. PARTICULARS TO BE KEPT IN DEALER'S REGISTER

- (1) For the purposes of section 28(2)(c) of the <u>Firearms Act</u>, the make, type, calibre and serial number of each firearm purchased and sold by a dealer are prescribed as matters to be shown in a register required by section 28(1) of the Firearms Act to be kept.
- (2) For the purposes of section 29 of the <u>Firearms Act</u>, the make, type, calibre and serial number of a firearm are the prescribed particulars to be recorded, not later than 24 hours after the sale by him of a firearm, in a register kept by the dealer.

5. PARTICULARS ENDORSED ON A PURCHASE PERMIT

For the purposes of section 63(a) of the <u>Firearms Act</u>, the particulars to be endorsed on a purchase permit where a Class C or Class D firearm is sold or disposed of are -

- (a) make, type, calibre and serial number of firearm;
- (b) the number and class of licence held by the purchaser; and
- (c) full name and address of person selling or disposing of firearm.

6. FORM OF APPEAL AGAINST COMMISSIONER'S DECISION

An appeal under section 73 of the <u>Firearms Act</u> against a decision of the Commissioner shall be in accordance with Form 1.

7. DUPLICATE CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION OR LICENCE

For the purposes of section 106A(2) of the <u>Firearms Act</u>, the prescribed fee for a duplicate certificate of registration or a duplicate licence is \$2.00.

8. COMMISSIONER'S DISCRETION

Without limiting the operation of these Regulations, the Commissioner may waive or reduce any fee prescribed by these Regulations in such circumstances as he thinks fit.
